Florida Birth-Related Neurological Injury Compensation Association (NICA) Fund

By law, all physicians licensed in Florida must pay into the NICA fund unless qualified for an exemption. Visit www.nica.com/medical-providers/ for information on who must pay NICA fees (NICA participating/NICA non-participating) and who is exempt from paying these statutorily required fees.

Please read the information found on the NICA website carefully prior to making your selection, as incorrect selections may result in the need for additional assessment of fees to be paid which can delay licensure or for a refund to be issued. Requests for refunds due to an overpayment can take several months to process.

"Participating," is for Florida licensed physicians who practice obstetrics or perform obstetrical services on a full or part-time basis and do not meet any of the exemption criteria. Participating physicians pay a \$5,000.00 fee.

"Non-participating," is for Florida licensed physicians who do not practice obstetrics or perform obstetrical services and do not meet any of the exemption criteria. Non-participating physicians pay a \$250.00 fee.

To determine if you qualify for exemption review the exemptions listed on page 24 of this application or visit the NICA website listed above. Physicians who are exempt do not pay a NICA fee. If you are a physician claiming exemption, you must send proof of your exemption to the board office and NICA.

Dispensing Practitioner Information

Dispensing practitioner registration is an optional registration for physicians whose primary practice is in the state of Florida. "**Dispensing**" is defined as the transfer of possession of medicinal drugs from a physician to a patient in the office. A practitioner who writes prescriptions or provides medicinal drugs labeled as "drug sample" or "complimentary drug" is not a "dispensing practitioner," and therefore does not need to register with the department. Section 465.0276, Florida Statutes, requires that licensees who dispense medicinal drugs pay a fee of \$100.00 at the time of registration and upon each renewal of the practitioner's license. It is unlawful for any person to sell samples or complimentary packages of drug products. A practitioner who confines their activities to dispensing complimentary packages of medicinal drugs to patients in the regular course of their practice **is not** required to register.
